Mike Trojan is the Chief Administrative Officer for the Regional Municipality of Niagara. Prior to assuming this role effective January 1, 2000, he was the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer and the Region's Treasurer and Director of Corporate Services. Before joining the Region in 1986, Mike held Treasurer positions in the City of Stoney Creek and the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake.

Mike was raised and educated in the Niagara Region and prior to commencing his municipal career he held positions with a public accounting firm, real estate developer, and a major Canadian financial institution.

Mike has been actively involved with professional and municipal associations, serving in various capacities. He has served on the Board of Directors for the Niagara Chapter of the Society of Management Accountants, the Municipal Finance Officers Association of Ontario (as Association Chair in 1992), ONE Financing Corporation (as President in 1992) and the Association of Municipalities of Ontario. He is presently Co-chair of the Steering Committee of the Ontario Municipal Benchmarking Initiative, member of Provincial-Municipal Fiscal Service Delivery Co-ordinating Table, Advisory Committee on Municipal Management/Innovation, and Vice-President of the Ontario Municipal Administrators Association.

At the community level, Mike has been involved as a coach/helper in a variety of youth sporting activities including Special Olympics. He is currently involved with the St. Catharines and area United Way Campaign serving as Community Campaign Chair in 2007 and Major Gifts Cabinet Chair in 2008.
